**Tuition: Preschool-12<sup>th</sup> Grade**

**\$3750.00 – 1<sup>st</sup> child**  
**\$3250.00 – each add'l child**

For your convenience, payments may be divided into 10 monthly payments due at the first of each month.

**\$375/mo, 1st child – \$325/mo, each add'l child**

The first payment is due August 1.  
Late fee of \$35 is charged on the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month.

from the total term tuition charges.*

### Lunch

**Grades K-5:** Lunch is included in tuition

**Grades 6-12:** \$125/month (\$12.50/day if no monthly plan)

### Breakfast

**Grades K-12:** \$75/month (\$7.50/day if no monthly plan)

### **Before/After School Program**

- \* \$125/month per child. Those not enrolled will be charged \$12.50/day.
- \* Grades Preschool-5<sup>th</sup>: Both before and after school programs available.
- \* Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>: Only after school available

### **Annual Enrollment/Book/Supply Fee: \$400 (Non-refundable)**

- \* \$320 (20% disc.) if paid in full by May 1
- \* or \$375 if paid between May 2 and June 15
- \* or \$400 after June 16
