August 17 - May 20

Tuition: Preschool-12th Grade
\$3850.00 – 1st child
\$3350.00 – each add'l child

Payments may be divided into 10 monthly payments due at the first of each month.

\$385/mo, 1st child – \$335/mo, each add'l child

The first payment is due August 1. Late fee of \$35 is charged on the 20th of each month.

Holidays have been deducted from the total term tuition charges.

Lunch

Grades K-5: Lunch is included in tuition
Grades 6-12: \$125/month (\$12.50/day if no monthly plan)

Breakfast

Grades K-12: \$75/month (\$7.50/day if no monthly plan)

Annual Enrollment/Book/Supply Fee: \$450
(Non-refundable)

- \$400 if paid in full by June 12
- Or \$425 if paid between June 15-26
- Or \$450 after June 26

Daily Schedule

Kindergarten-12th Grade: 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m.

Before/After School Program

- \$125/month per child. Those not enrolled will be charged \$12.50/day.
- Grades Preschool-5th: Both before and after school programs available.
- Grades 6th – 8th. After school only

Grades K-5, 1:00-2:30 P.M.

Grades 6-12, 2:30-4:00 P.M.

GENERAL POLICIES

Dress Code

Withdrawals

Withdrawals from school must be finalized through the main office.

Discipline

Parental Commitment

Parents should understand when enrolling their child at Liberty Academy that they are pledging to support biblical principles as well as policies listed in this brochure and the student handbook.

Grade Standards

Students are expected to maintain a grade of C in all subjects. Some exceptions will be made for those who are definitely unable to work at their grade level.

Report Cards

- Report cards will be sent home at 9-week periods.
- Interim progress reports will be sent home mid-way between report cards.
- These report cards and progress reports must be signed by parents and returned the following day.

Non-Payment of Tuition

In the event of withdrawal, transfer, or expulsion, parents are responsible for full payment of tuition and other fees.

Liberty Academy reserves the right to withhold report cards and student records until tuition and other fees have been paid in full.
